

## FIELD TRIPS

### 1. Omaka Airfield Hangars

**Cost \$10**

Three private hangars will be open, giving registrants a unique opportunity to view closely and photograph a wide range of classic airworthy aircraft. Craft owners will be on hand to briefly describe the aircraft. One hangar also houses six classic motor cycles of various vintage, gliders and cars.

**Numbers are limited** to the first 25 who register for this field trip.



### 2. Brayshaw Heritage Park

**No Charge**

The Park houses a collection of original Marlborough buildings and memorabilia, and is the location for a number of groups dedicated to the collection and restoration of Marlborough's heritage: Vintage Farm Machinery, Vintage Car Club, Riverside Railway, Associated Modellers Society, Vintage Fire Truck Museum .....

The Modellers Society will have their miniature railway operating, and the Vintage Farm Machinery buildings will be open, with members working with the impressive display of crawlers, tractors and other machinery from Marlborough's past.



### **3. Taylor Dam Recreation Reserve**

**No Charge**

This earth dam was built in 1965 to provide flood protection for Blenheim. The lake behind the dam is a breeding sanctuary for black swans, ducks, coots, pukeko and grebes, plus many other species of birds in the surrounding native and exotic trees.

There are excellent opportunities for birdlife photography, and easy walks with tree, lake and landscape views. Gumboots or other waterproof footwear are advisable.
